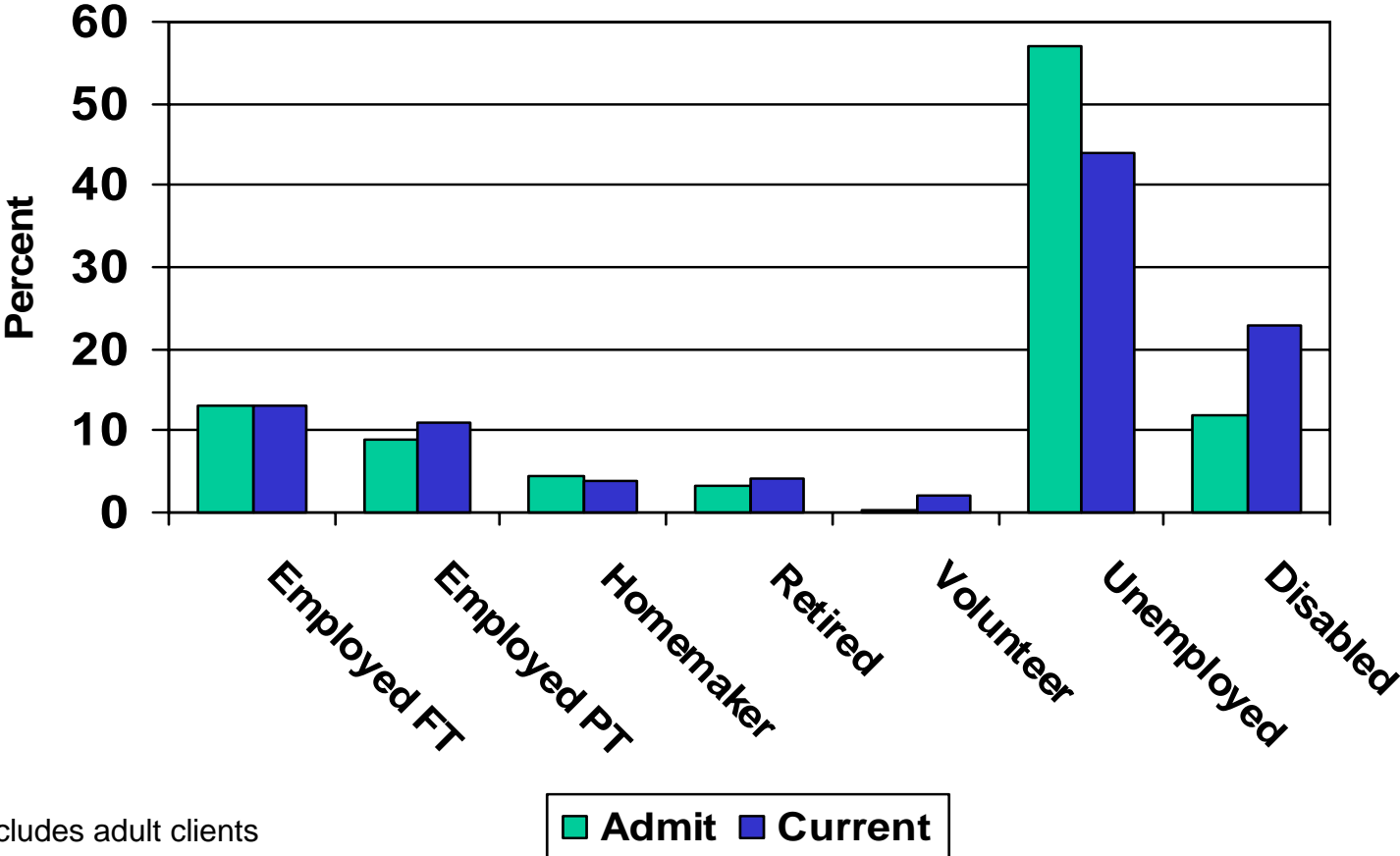

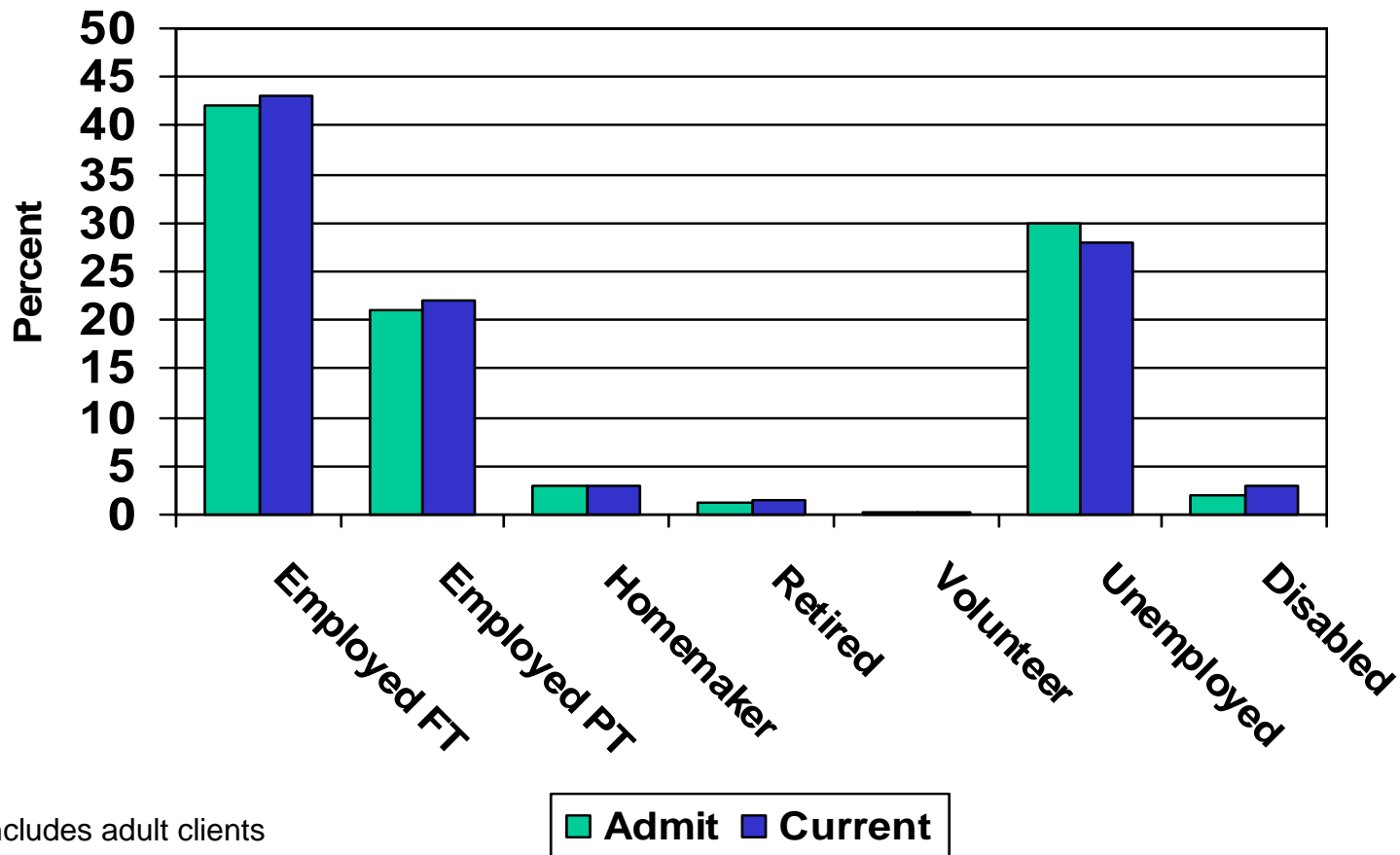

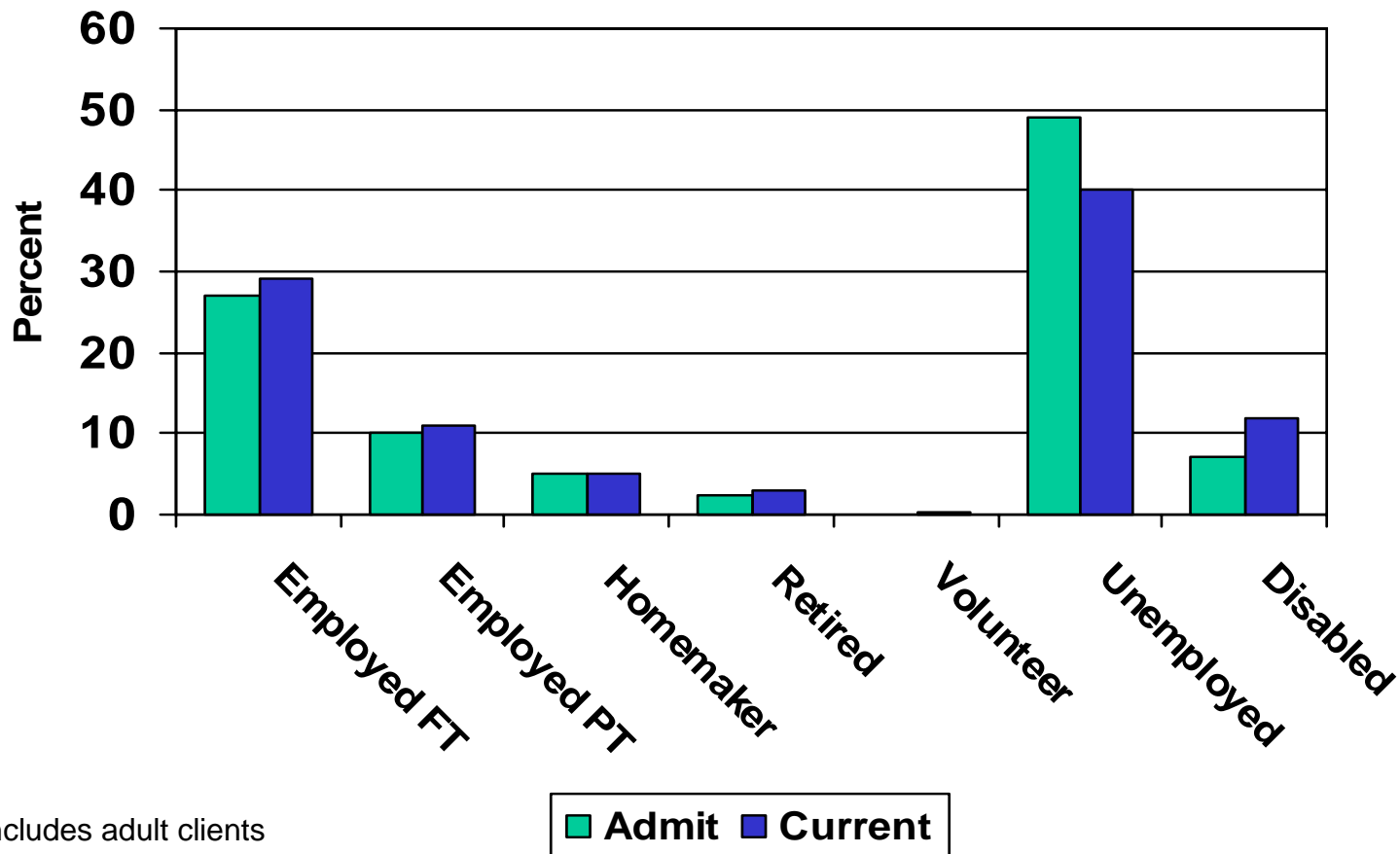

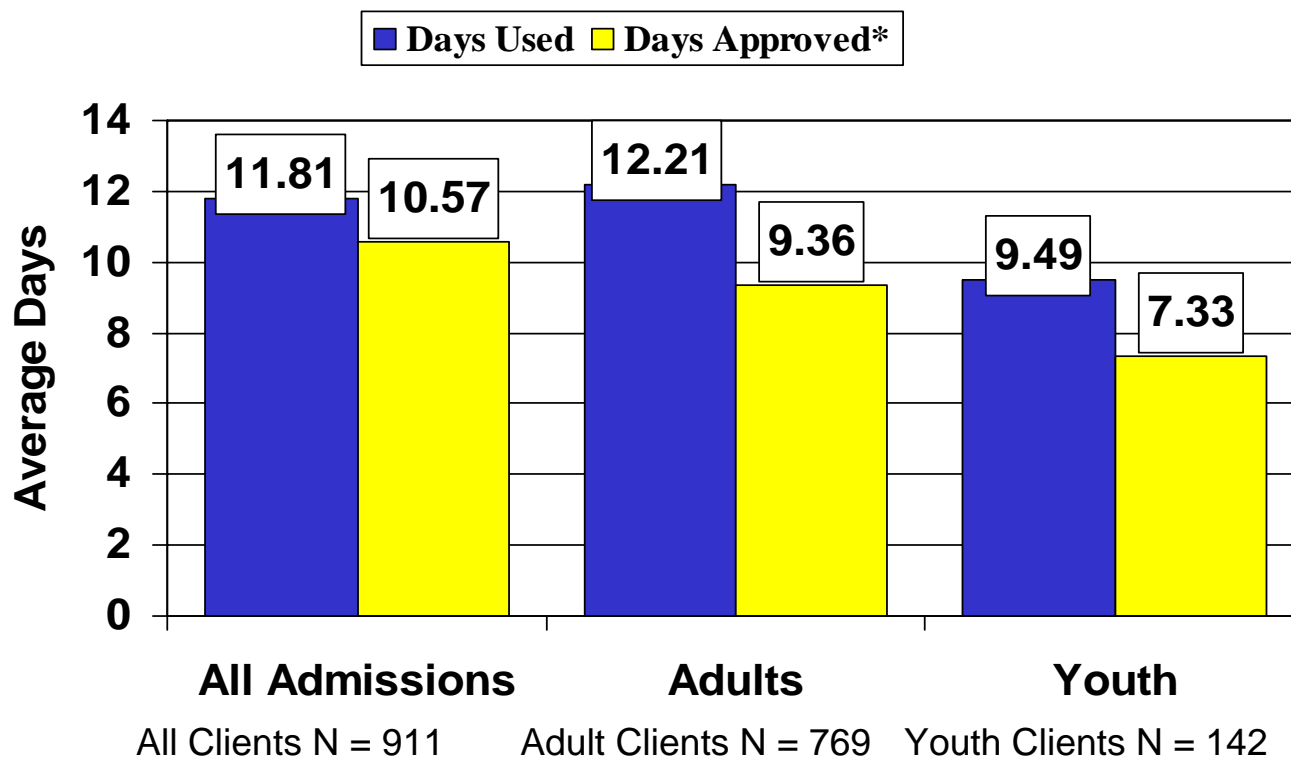
Hospitalization Rates

* Approved Length of Stay for Medicaid Funded

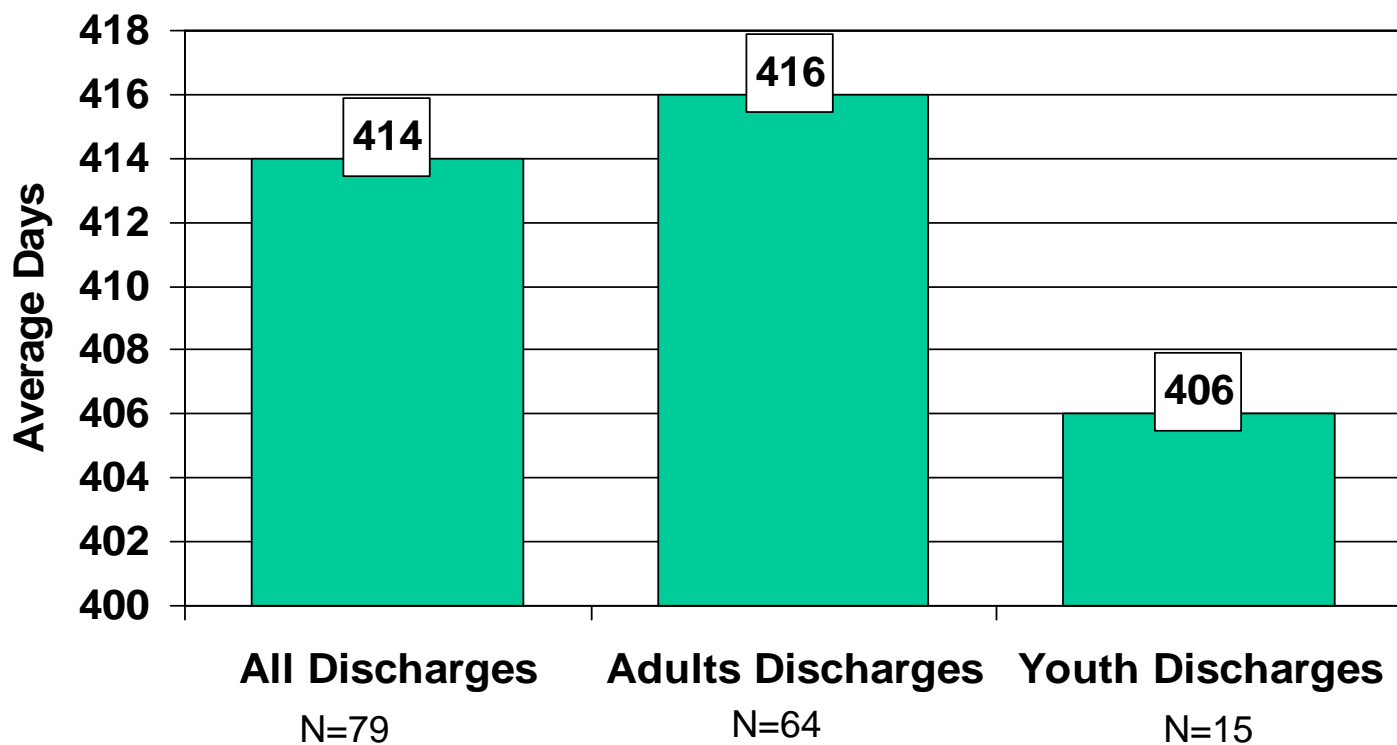

Average Length Of Inpatient Stay Per Discharge

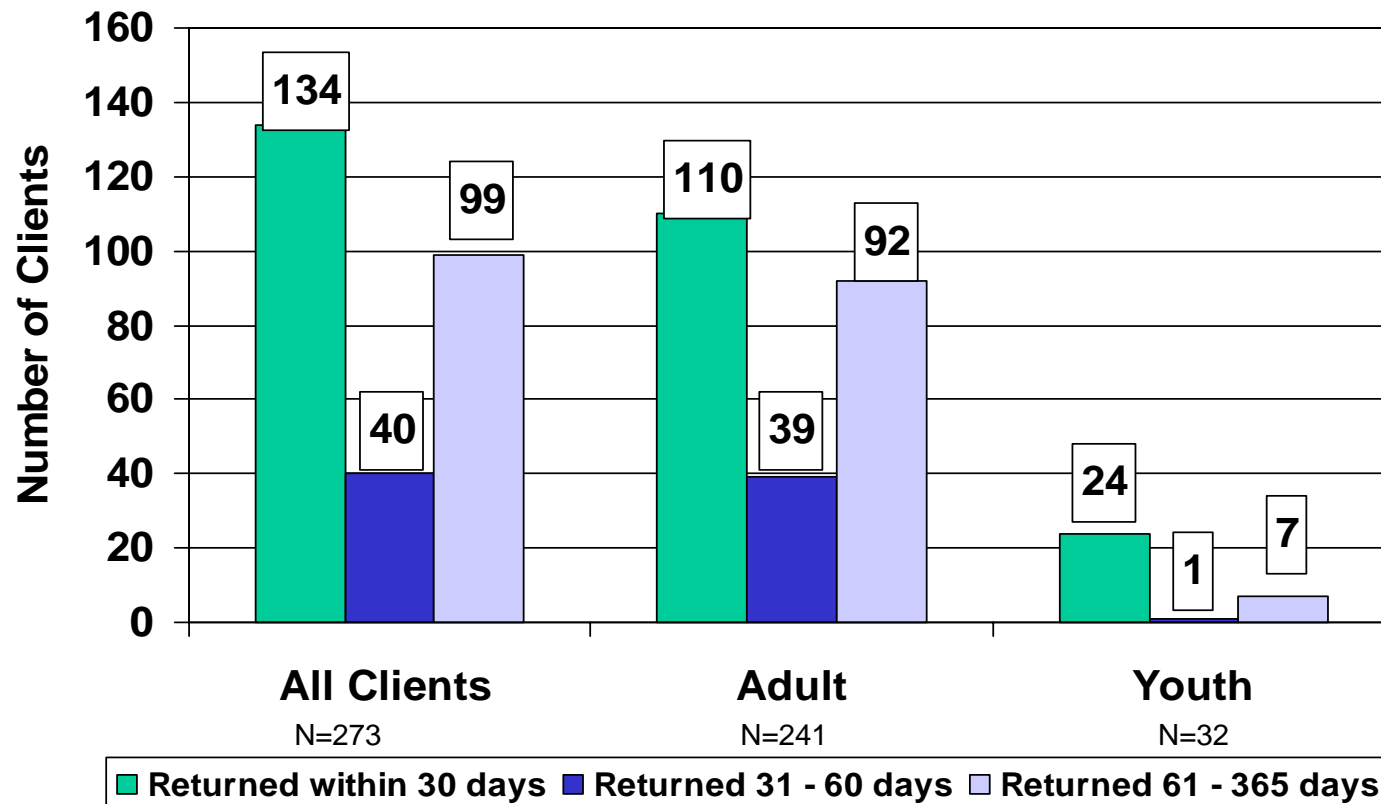
